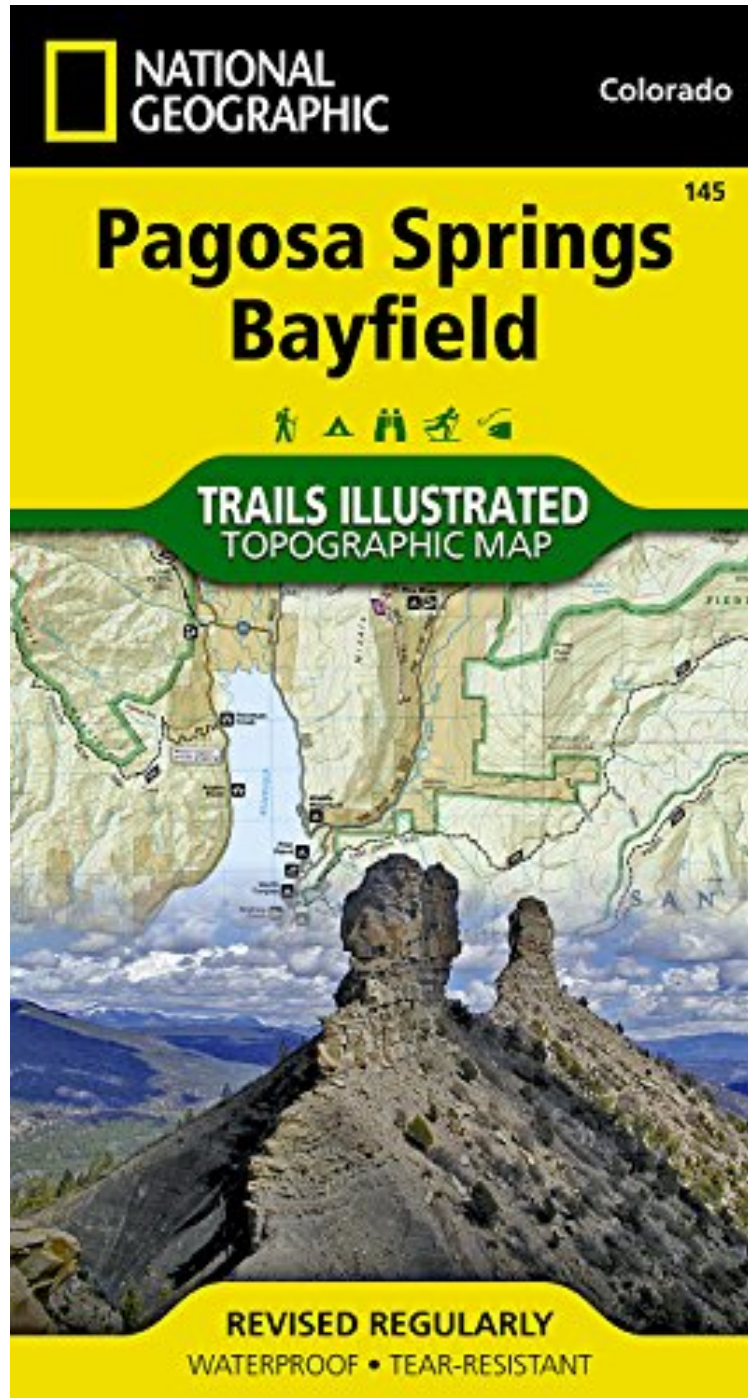

A local friend showed me this map a while back and I immediately went home to buy one here on . It's so much easier to read than the forest service maps! Any time I have friends visiting who want to hike or bike a trail for their first time this is the map that I show them. I hike, bike, and run a lot around the Pagosa Springs area and have used this map to get familiar with the layout of the area trails. It's also great for determining what is public, private, and BLM land in the area for hiking and hunting purposes. I haven't taken it out during my hikes, but it does appear to be a very sturdy waterproof material that should last a long time even with rigorous outdoor use.

Grids clearly marked without being intrusive.
Doesn't ring at you like a Google maps device.
Cons: Shows non-existing roads (I found a few roads marked that don't exist North West of Pagosa, but who knows which other roads aren't actually there?)
Topographical lines are marked by 80 feet. Hope you learned your times tables!
There were a couple spots that looked like they shouldn't be too steep but in reality took all fours to get up and down. (Even the seasoned geologist on the trip thought the slope was poorly marked, and that guy dreams in topo maps)

Waterproof Tear-Resistant Topographic Map
National Geographic's Trails Illustrated map of Pagosa Springs and Bayfield provides unparalleled detail of this area on the western slope of the Continental Divide in southwestern Colorado. Expertly researched and created in partnership with the U.S. Forest Service, Southern Ute Indian Tribe, Bureau of Land Management and others, the map's coverage includes San Juan National Forest, Piedra Area and River, Vallecito and Lemon Reservoirs, Chimney Rock National Monument and Southern Ute Indian Reservation. Get off the beaten path and back on again by following the map to trailheads and then along trails that are labeled according to their designated usage. High clearance and four-wheel drive roads are marked as well. To aid in your navigation, the map includes contour lines, elevations, labeled peaks, water features, waypoints, and clear boundaries between national park and Indian land, which is closed to the public for recreational purposes. Many recreation points of interest, for all seasons, are clearly noted, including campgrounds and campsites, cross-country ski areas and snowmobile trails, boat launch and river access points, fishing areas, scenic viewpoints and wildlife viewing areas. In addition, the map provides background information of the area, survival tips and contact information of both public and private organizations involved in maintaining the region. Every Trails Illustrated map is printed on "Backcountry Tough" waterproof, tear-resistant paper. A full UTM grid is printed on the map to aid with GPS navigation. Other features found on this map include: Mesa Mountains, Navajo River, San Juan National Forest, Vallecito Reservoir, Weminuche Wilderness.
