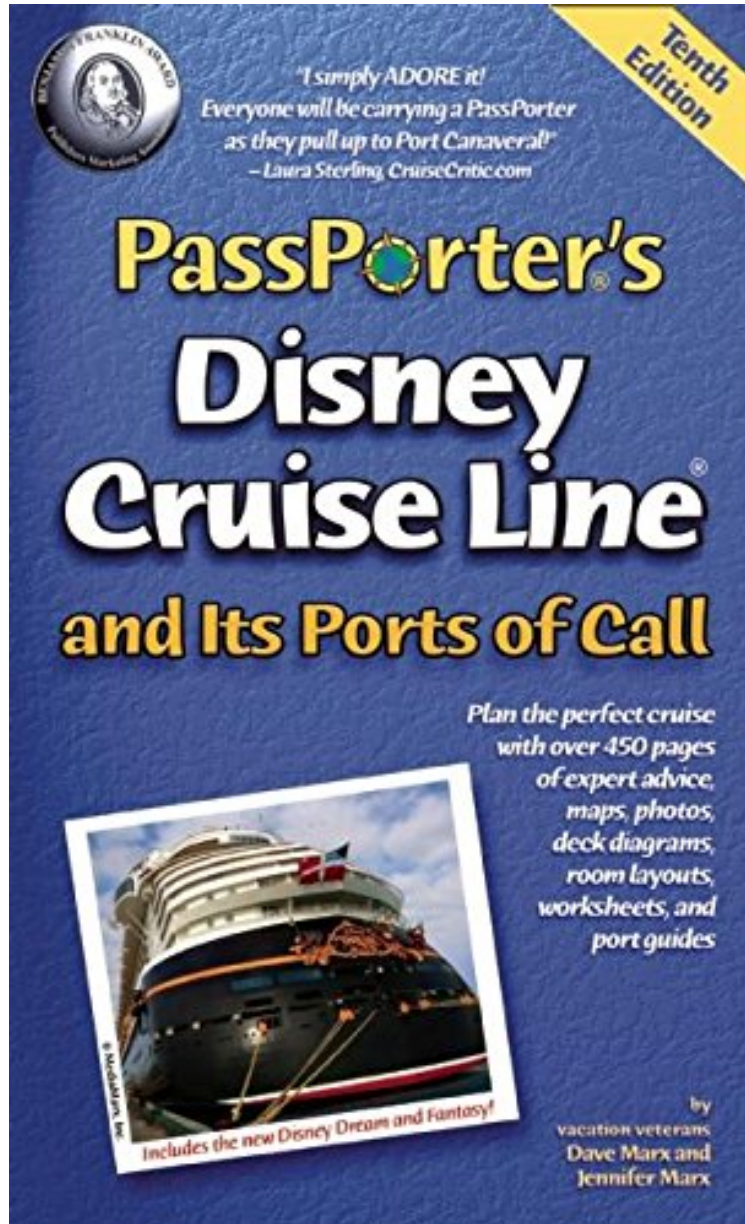

Disney Cruise Line and Its Ports of Call is the best book available for planning a Disney cruise. I've been waiting all year for the Tenth Edition to be released after a number of publishing delays. It's finally here! There is a wealth of information in this book. It doesn't matter whether you are new to Disney cruising or have taken a number of Disney cruises. There is so much information in this book, even experienced cruisers are bound to learn something new. I am planning my 3rd Disney cruise and this book will be very helpful. It is informative and just plain fun to read in anticipation of our next cruise! The Tenth Edition includes information on the new Dream and Fantasy ships. This book has worksheets for estimating your cruise expenses, cruise reservations, and travel arrangements. It also includes a packing list. There is information on selecting your sail dates, itinerary comparisons, money saving ideas and a chart comparing the various Disney ships. I think the deck plans in this book are better than those in the Disney Cruise catalog. Information about all of the restaurants and sample menus is included. There are diagrams and photos of each of the cabin categories, which helps when deciding what type of cabin you want, along with the pros and cons of cabin locations. There is a chapter that covers the variety of shipboard entertainment for all ages, with great info about the kids clubs. The Ports of Call chapter is fantastic. It provides maps of the various ports and descriptions of the many shore excursions along with cost, length of excursion and rating. The information about the cruise ports (Port Canaveral, Galveston, etc.) is also very helpful. There are plenty of photos (all black and white) throughout the book. If there is one "con" about this book, it is that one member or another of the authors family are in most of the photos. I feel like I'm looking at their vacation photos, rather than photos from a travel guide! That doesn't really detract from the usefulness of the book, however. This is a fantastic book..... I wouldn't consider planning a Disney cruise without it!
