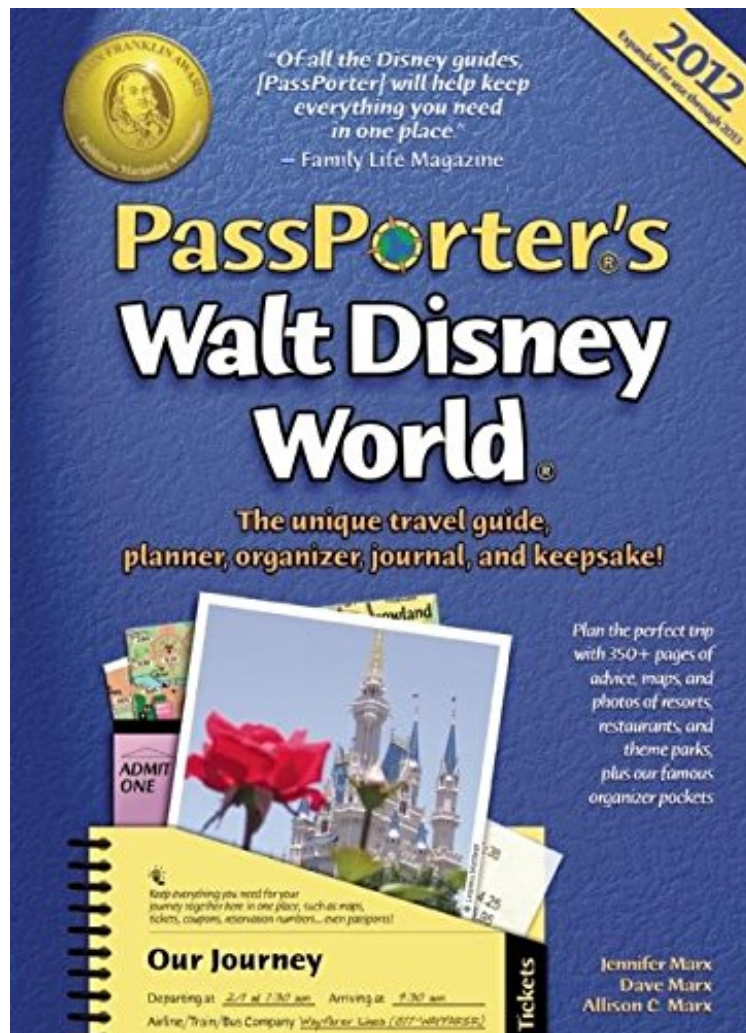

This book is perfect for what we wanted to use it for. Great detailed information about all of the resorts and parks, reviews of the restaurants and rides, and places to make your own notes along the way. I loved that the book had a page for orienting yourself to each park before the chapter got into the details of the park itself. The full color, fold out maps are also very helpful. Each section for the parks also had great tips for making the most out of the park and tips for the best places to see the shows and parades. I also loved the charting the attractions section at the end of each parks chapter. I really loved that the author and family all gave their own opinion about each ride and attraction. It gave different points of view from several different age groups to help make the decision as to whether or not we would enjoy the attraction. Another part of the book that I found very useful and informative was the Making More Magic section. It had great advice for finding some of the great lesser known parts of the parks and making the most of the behind the scenes tours that Disney World offers. This section also has a great page with hints about finding the hidden Mickeys around the park and a section where you can notate where they are when you find them. It just adds another dimension to one of my favorite things to do at Disney. The last part of the book has a section where you can notate every part of your trip to Disney on these great card stock pages that will stand the test of time with your memories written on them. There is a card for the trip down, the room, each day at the parks, and any memories that you would want to jot down. Each card has a pocket where you can store things like tickets, receipts, baggage claims, card keys, and other things to help make each part of the vacation as memorable as possible. Having a place to put these items and notes will come in very handy years down the road when we are planning future trips and want to bring back the memory of this one.
