It is mostly Emperors, Kings, and Gentoos penguins. Most other species of penguins are missing. My other problem with this book is the format. At 7 inches by 10 inches, it is about half the size of most other photo books on penguins. It makes it hard to see the penguins in some of the pictures. Also, there is not very much information about the natural history of the penguins. "Penguin Life: Surviving With Style in the South Atlantic" has some really nice photos but unless you have a lot of other penguin photo books, you can find better ones elsewhere.
