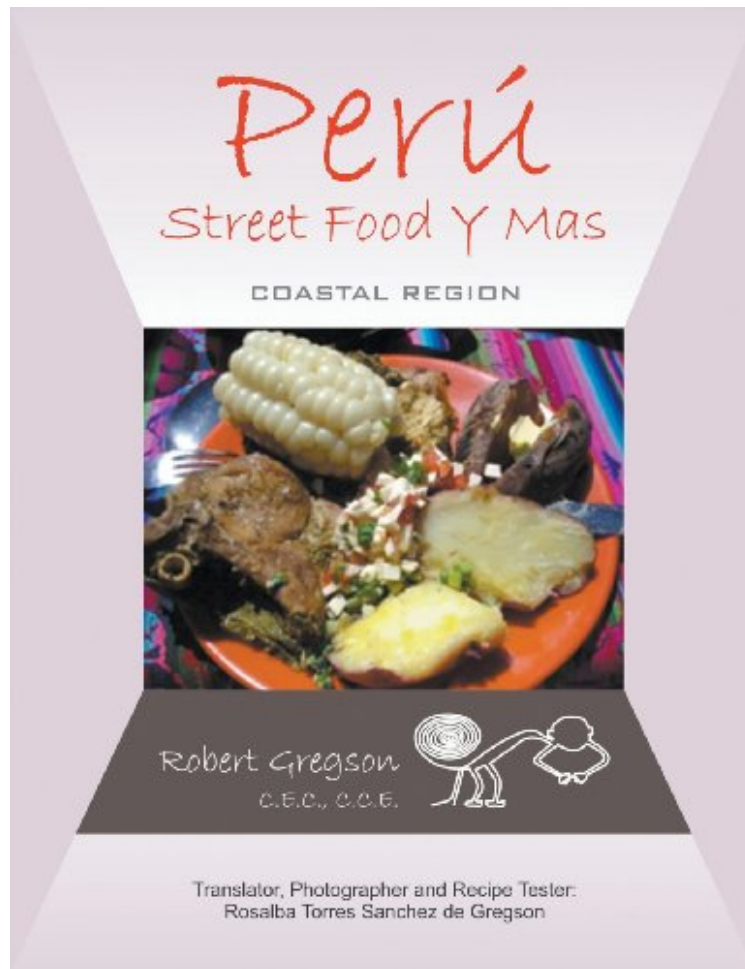

You may ask, "What's cooking?" in the new cookbook/travelogue Peru - Street Food Y Mas. A culinary educator visiting Peru to study the local cuisine, author Robert Gregson got more than he bargained for when he met his future wife, Rosalba, in Lima. Spending six months in Peru for the past two summers traveling, collecting recipes and learning the history of Peruvian street food, the author is now semi-retired and writing his first book. He says thirteen of his family members have been chefs. Peru has three regions, and this first book covers the coastal area.
