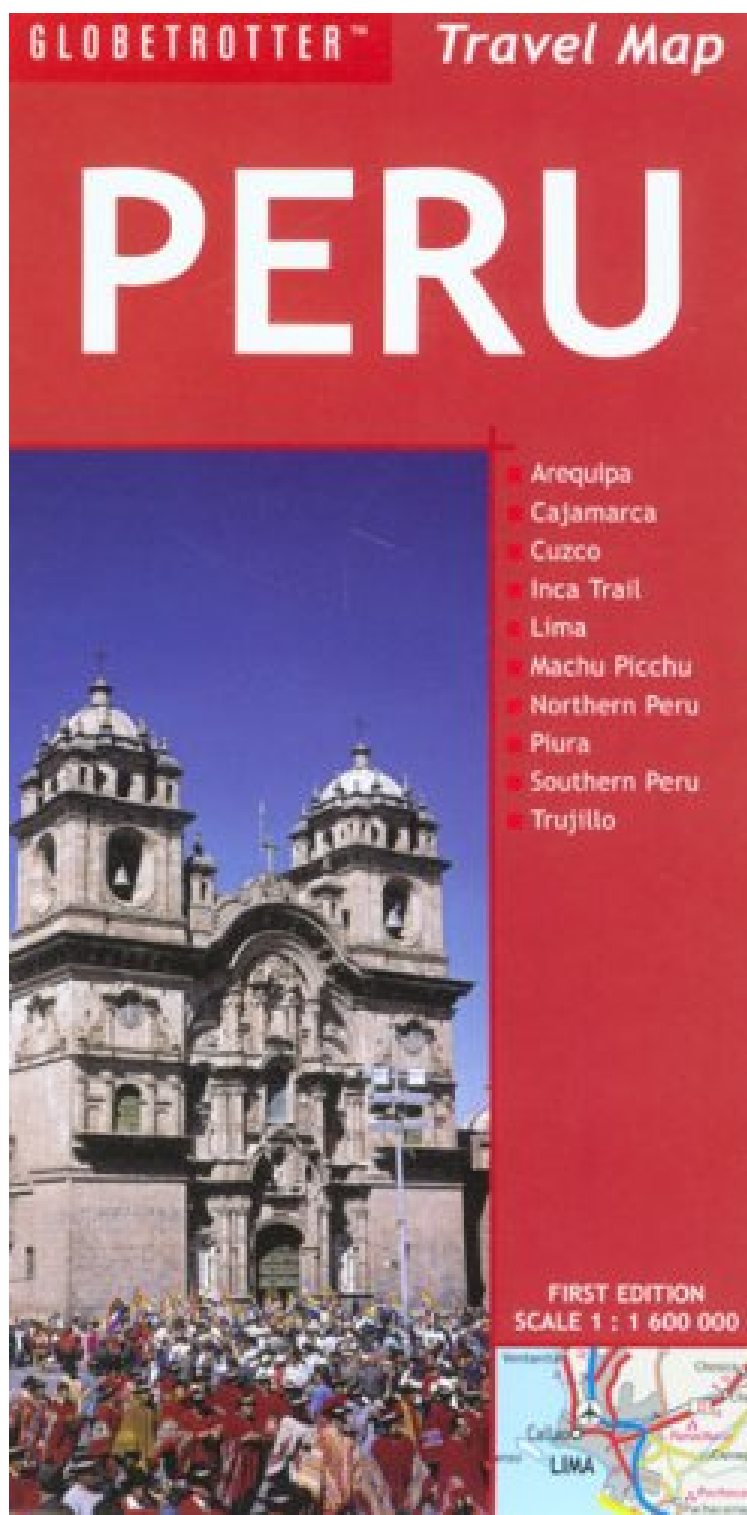

spent two weeks driving through Southern Peru, with a Garmin GPS for navigation and this map as a back up. This map does not show any of the smaller villages and roads that are on the free digital GPS map at [...]. It includes some detail city maps, but they show less detail than the free maps you can get at each hotel. But a more important flaw is that it shows a main road between Arequipa and Juliaca that runs through Chiguata. The real main road runs through Yura, but is shown on this map as a minor road. We trusted this map, and ended up backtracking through hellish Arequipa traffic, losing about half a day in the process. It is an OK map to orient yourself with prior to your trip, or to follow along if you are in an organized tour.
