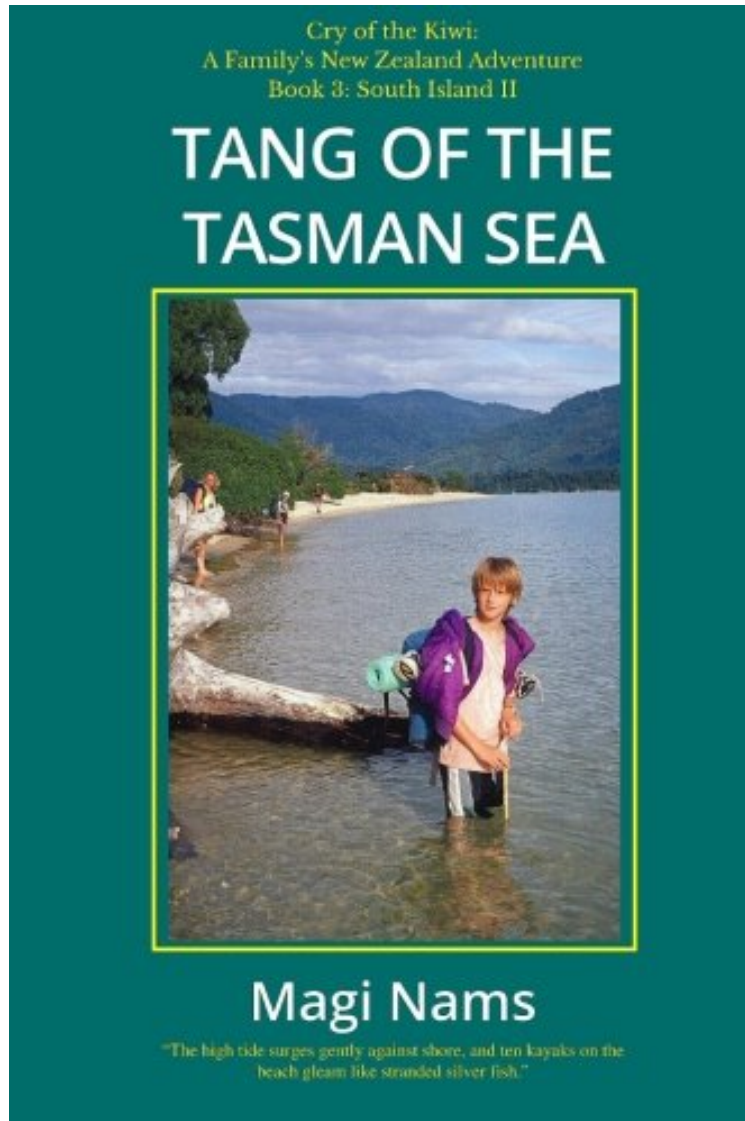

After a quick Australian vacation, replete with kangaroos, koalas, and kookaburras, the family hikes to brooding Cave Creek, with its history of disaster, and follows flashlights deep into West Coast caves. Between winter storms, they hike a rain-drenched West Coast beach and climb through rainforest to a spectacular lookoff over Franz Josef Glacier. Along the way, Magi Nams reflects on her family's growing immersion in Kiwi life, on lessons learned, and on the impact of invasive species on native ecosystems. As this travel adventure of a lifetime draws to a close, it becomes clear that the heart of New Zealand lies in more than its riveting landscapes and intriguing flora and fauna.
