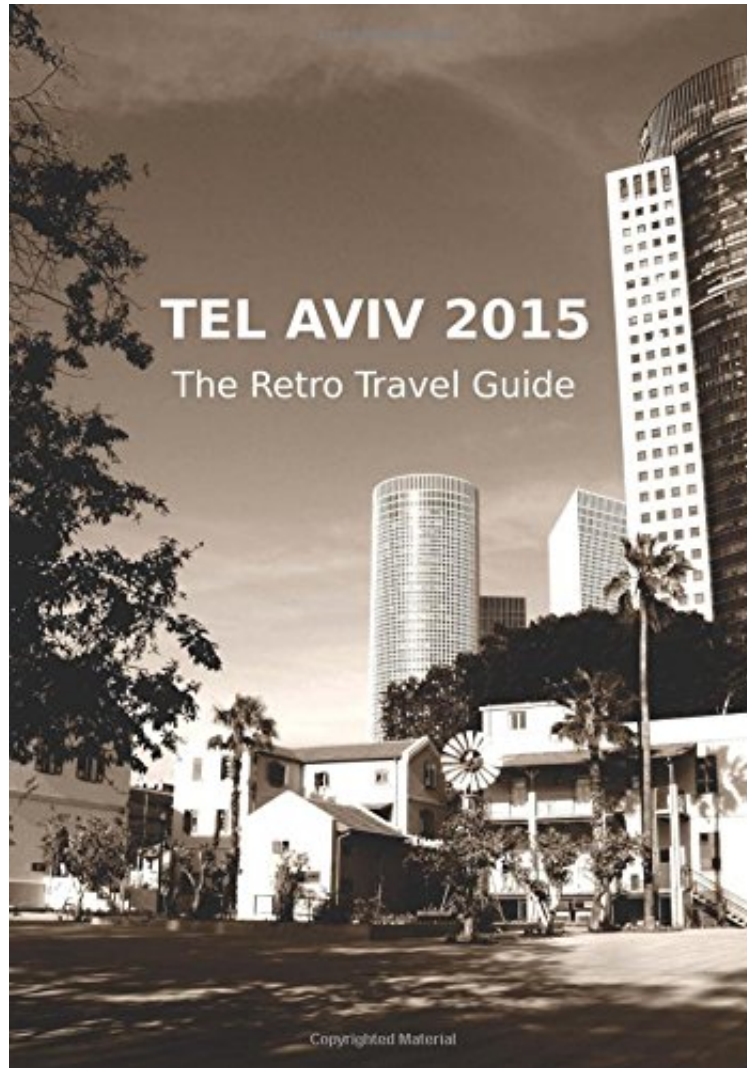

There are some good historical details, interesting facts and purportedly "up-to-date" information related to 2014, but, although the cover is clearly marked "2015" quite a lot of the material has not been updated from previous editions. For example, it has been years since there were cinemas in the Opera Tower, and a walking tour of Jaffa marks highlights long gone. The format is clear, but the language is a little quaint and slightly labored. I was happy to find a guide which celebrated a certain retro style and departed from the slick Lonely Planet formula, and I don't regret having it along with me on my visit to Israel. It just needs a sharper rewrite and perhaps some more illustrations.
