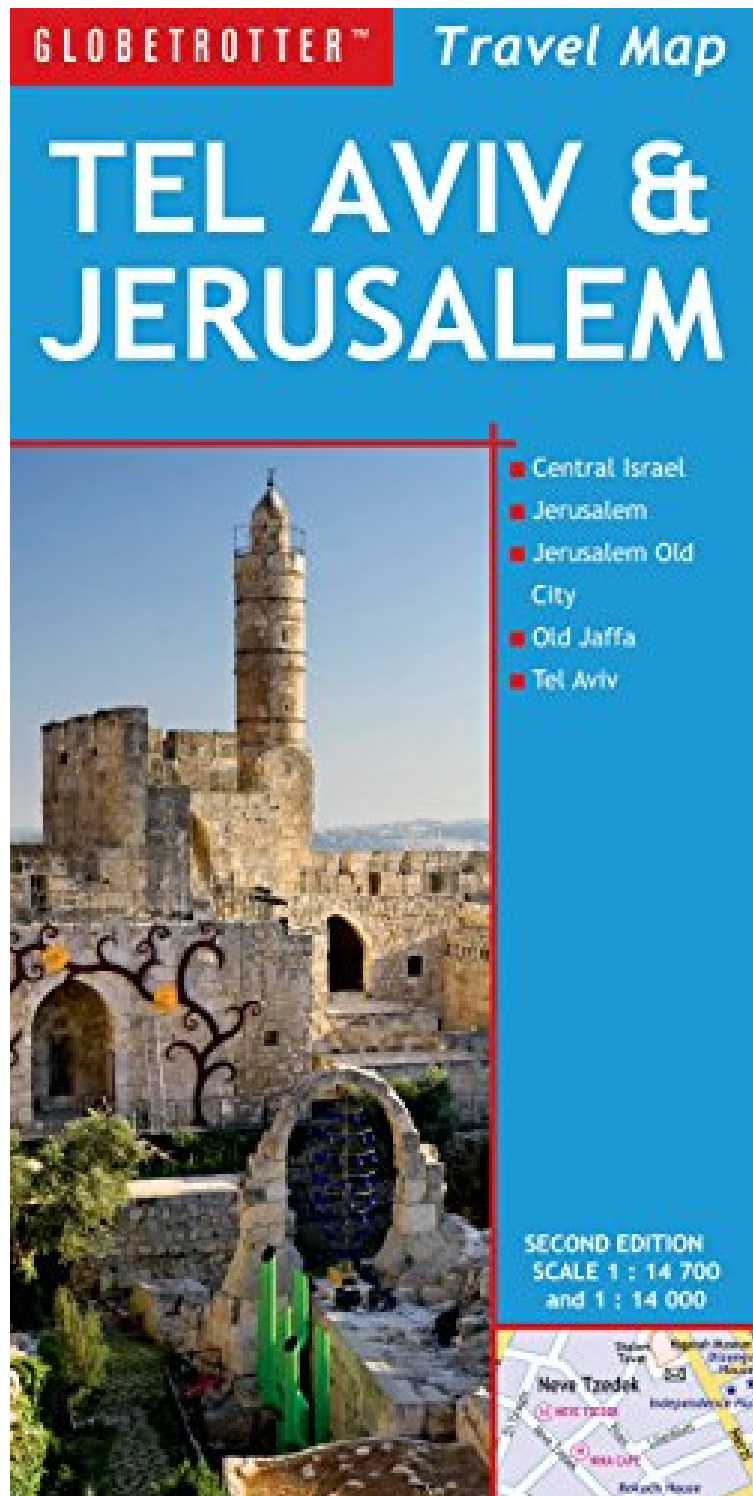

The map states that it "includes detailed street plans of the cities . . ." That is where it is lacking. Well, let's look at the pros and cons:
PRO: - One side illustrates the major roads of central Israel - It's easily readable - It lists some hotels in Tel Aviv and Jerusalem - Streets are clearly marked
CON: - The central Israel map does not show every town, village, kibbutz. For example, Modi'in and Latrun on the road to Jerusalem are missing - A large number of the smaller Tel Aviv streets are missing. This is not the map to use if you need to visit someone on Tchernikovsky Street or if someone told you to walk down Shalom Aleikhem Street to get to the US Embassy. From the look of the Jerusalem map, the same applies there. - If you're looking for a hotel, the map only shows 4- and 5-star hotels.
I bought the map to replace the Map Guide of Tel Aviv and Yafo by Mapa Publishers (ASIN: 965718438X) which was damaged from use. This map showed all the streets of Tel Aviv, although it was a bit harder to read. But that's no longer available, at least on Amazon.
Maybe if you want to drive and stay on the larger streets, then this would be more appropriate for moving about Tel Aviv and Yafo - but you better bring along a GPS or you won't find that sushi restaurant on Idelson in Tel Aviv.
