The book's concept - Camellia N. travels the globe through her nightly dreams - is a fantastic way to instantly transport readers to places they've never been. In this adventure, Camellia explores the Arctic; meets several endangered animals; and experiences the Aurora Borealis (inspiring even adults to want to plan their next vacation to the polar region). I love how the animals featured also tap into childhood pop culture. The beluga whale provides great context for the well-known Raffi song, "Baby Beluga," and using Rudolph to help readers understand caribou is brilliant. The illustrations are colorful, engaging and descriptive in their storytelling and add to the book's overall sense of wonder.
